How does the Furniture Fund work?

- Identify your unwanted furniture
- Contact the Furniture Fund team to arrange a quote for removal cost and resell value
- Your furniture will be safely removed at a time convenient to you
- Your furniture will be resold, reused or remanufactured, saving the environment
- You will be provided with rebate of which you can choose to donate to PIF Furniture Fund
- You will receive a tax deductible invoice for your donation
- You will receive a sustainability statement on your positive impact on the environment

What examples of furniture would be best used for the program?

Chairs, table desks, office lounges, reception counters, coffee tables

Where do your donation funds go?

Funds raised by your donations go towards building a home for young people, to overcome life challenges. And be guided towards taking back their place in the community to either study or work.
